
We have enclosed copies of the records in our possession responsive to your request.

Thank you for writing to the Lake County Health Department with your request for information pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 et seq. On **August 10, 2022**, you requested the following records:


I am requesting all information regarding any and all violations at this site including health, safety, environmental at the CHDS, LLC facility located at 25199 W. IL Rte. 120, Round Lake, IL 60073.

Under the Freedom of Information Act, a public body may extend the time to respond to a FOIA request by up to 5 business days for a limited number of reasons. 5 ILCS 140/3(e). We are extending the time to respond to your request by 5 business days for the following reason(s):

- The requested records are stored in whole or in part at another location(s). 5 ILCS 140/3(e)(i).
- The request requires the collection of a substantial number of specified records. 5 ILCS 140/3(e)(ii).
- The request is categorical in nature and requires an extensive search for responsive records. 5 ILCS 140/3(e)(iii).
- The requested records have not been located in the course of routine search and additional efforts are being made to locate them. 5 ILCS 140/3(e)(iv).
- In order to determine whether the requested records are exempt under Section 7 of FOIA or must be redacted in part before they are disclosed, we must have the documents reviewed by the appropriate personnel. 5 ILCS 140/3(e)(v).
- It would unduly burden or interfere with our operations to fill the request within the initial five business days. 5 ILCS 140/3(e)(vi).
- There is a need for consultation with another public body or among two or more components of a public body having a substantial interest in the determination or in the subject matter of the request. 5 ILCS 140/3(e)(vii).

Accordingly, we will respond to your request by **August 22, 2022**.
