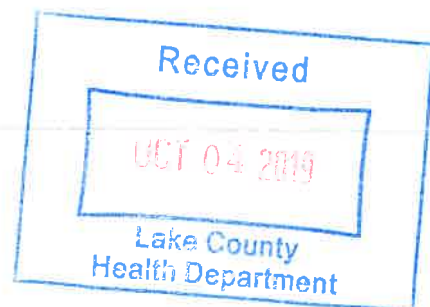
Violation Response Letter and CCA Request:

1. We greatly apologize for the alleged violation. The reason this violation occurred was our misunderstanding that the earthwork must be completed before starting waste import and composting operations.
2. CHDS will correct violation with the following actions:
 1. We immediately stopped excepting landscape waste.
 2. Final grading has been established on western ten-acre portion of the parcel and will be confirmed by village engineer.
 3. We have resubmitted to the IEPA Springfield office to permit just that portion of the final graded acreage.
 4. Once approved by necessary parties we will immediately move all materials from non-completed grading areas to the final graded ten acres.
3. CHDS can confirm final grading in that ten-acre area and move existing material within thirty days if approved to do so.
4. To ensure this type of violation does not occur in the future, CHDS will only place material in approved final graded areas. If expansion is required, we will make sure that the area is approved for its final grading and approved to expand by the IEPA and LCHD before moving forward.
5. At this time CHDS, would like to request a CCA if the terms are expectable, and push forward towards future operations.
